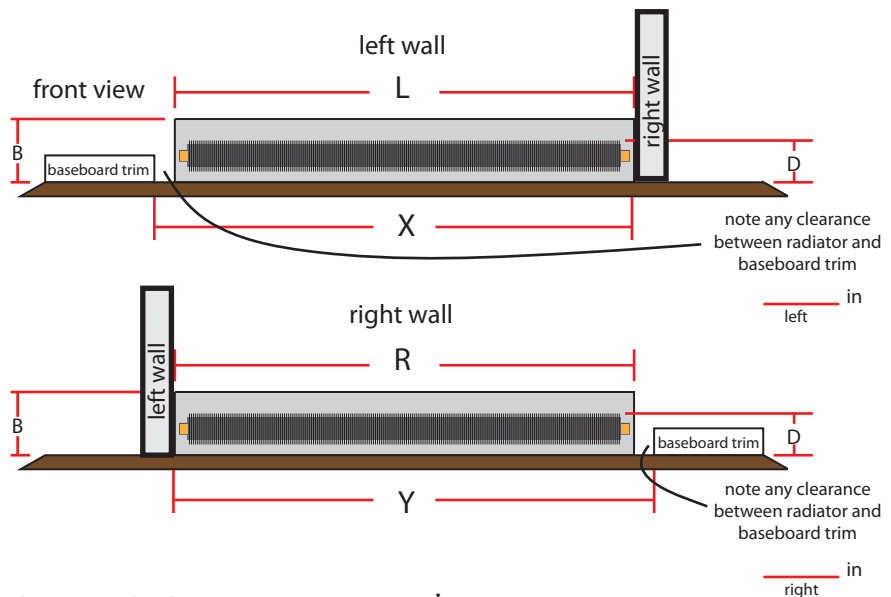
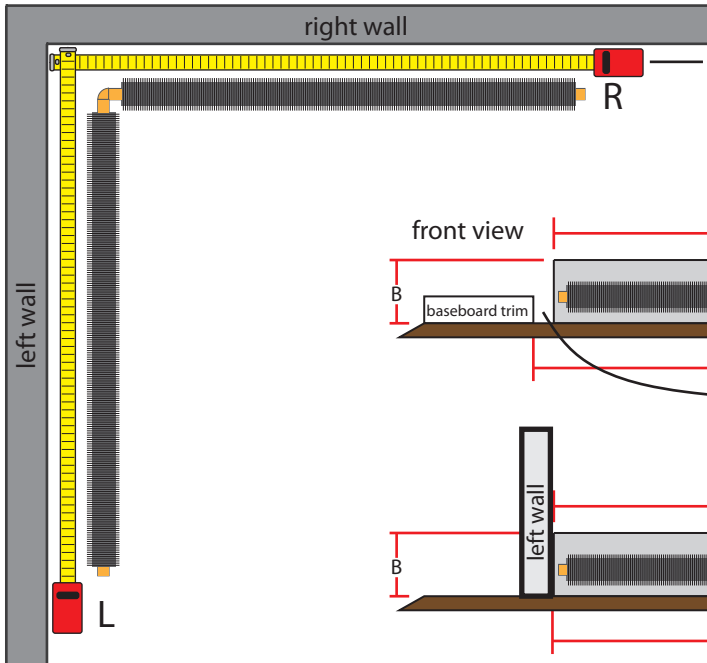

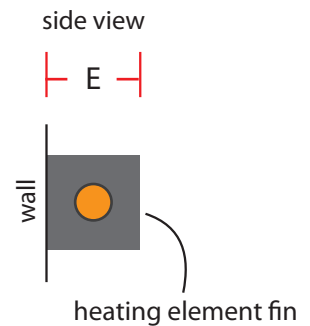
# Measurement Guide Inside Corners

If it applies, remove cover and existing end caps for measurements. Leave backplate in place.  
Measurements are referenced from facing directly at the radiator.

top view



- L measurement from right wall to farthest left of radiator \_\_\_\_\_ in  
include any fittings such as valves and piping
- R measurement from left wall to farthest right of radiator \_\_\_\_\_ in  
include any fittings such as valves and piping
- B measurement from floor to top of existing backplate \_\_\_\_\_ in  
enter highest measurement from either wall  
if no existing backplate, skip
- X measurement from inside of baseboard trim to opposite wall \_\_\_\_\_ in  
if no baseboard trim, skip
- Y measurement from inside of baseboard trim to opposite wall \_\_\_\_\_ in  
if no baseboard trim, skip
- D measurement from floor to top of heating element fin \_\_\_\_\_ in
- E measurement from wall to front of heating element fin \_\_\_\_\_ in  
enter highest measurement from either wall



In some situations you may have to cut away a section of the baseboard trim in order to install the covers flush to the wall. In order to prevent any gaps in the transition from the covers to the baseboard trim, please try to provide as many measurements as possible.
